Job Description:

Experience in teaching and directing is desired but not essential. Your responsibilities will include planning and delivering engaging sessions that cover dancing, singing, and acting, culminating in a series of showpieces for both film and stage performances.

In addition, there will be opportunities for those suitably qualified to teach 1:1 Singing, and/or 1:1 Dancing classes throughout the week as well.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver weekly musical theatre sessions for club members of varying abilities, aged 4 and up (including adults).
- Teach and develop skills in singing and dancing.
- Select appropriate musical theatre, dance, and choral pieces for students to perform.
- Direct and choreograph song and dance routines.
- Foster a positive and inclusive environment where all students feel encouraged and supported.

- Prepare students for end-of-term performances and/or showcases.
- Collaborate with other staff and volunteers to ensure smooth operation of the club.
- Communicate regularly with parents/guardians regarding students' club activities.

- Occasional Backstage / Front of House work for End of Term Performances.
